Over the duration of the course, you'll learn a variety of new skills which could include;

- The fundamentals of soil preparation
- Planting
- Maintenance
- Sustainable gardening practices

On completion of this course you will achieve:

- C&G Level 1 Certificate in Practical Horticulture
