This certification is a crucial requirement for individuals looking to work on construction sites across the UK, ensuring that all workers meet the necessary health, safety, and environmental standards.

This course is intended for anyone who is seeking a role that would require entering a Construction site this could include construction workers, cleaners, security staff and site administrators.
