The Level 3 Certificate in Social Prescribing will prepare you for a role in social prescribing and provides those already working in this area with a deeper level of knowledge and understanding of social prescribing.

When does this start and end?

- 2 June 2025 - 18 August 2025

What are the entry requirements?

You will need a GCSE in English Grade 9-4 (A*-C) or Functional Skills English Level 2. Previous experience in the subject, through work or education, is desirable.

It would be an advantage for any undertaking this Certificate to have access to a relevant working environment or simulated working environment in Health Care, Social Care, or the Voluntary Community Social Enterprise sector.

This Certificate is aimed primarily at those working or looking to work in healthcare, local government and the voluntary and community sector and will enable you to broaden your
